# Applying for a Passport

U.S. Passports are only issued by the U.S. State Department. Processing usually takes six weeks (but it can take longer). Processing can be expedited for an additional fee.

For our customer's convenience, we keep extra passport applications on hand. The full detailed application instructions are included with the Passport application.

### *Where To Apply*

If this is your first passport, you will need to applying in person at a government office that accepts passport applications.

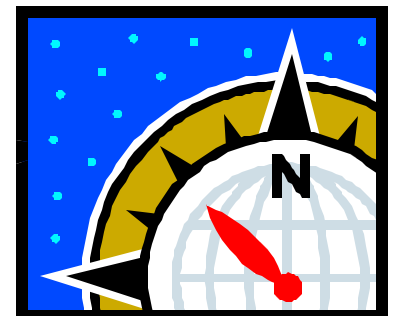

- **Plymouth Post Office**, 100 Long Pond Road, 508-746-0058. Monday—Friday 9 am—3 pm

### *Things You Need*

When applying, you'll need to bring:

- **Two passport photos**
- **Proof of identity** (*driver's license*)
- **Proof of your US Citizenship** (*usually a certified birth certificate*)
- **Two checks for the fees.** (*Some facilities may accept Credit Cards*)

### ***Passport Photos***

Before you apply, you'll need to have your photograph taken according to government specifications and printed on passport compliant paper.

Noble's makes the passport photo experience the easiest and quickest on the South Shore.

***No appointment is needed.***

### ***Birth Certificates***

Native Massachusetts residents can get certified birth certificates from the Massachusetts Bureau of Vital Records 617.740.2600. They are located on the first floor at 150 Mt. Vernon Street in Dorchester. They are open Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 8:45 am - 4:45 pm, Tuesday and Thursdays from 8:45 am - 7 pm. Their web address is:

If you were born out of state, ask our staff for the list of phone numbers of the state vital records departments.

### ***Application Fees***

Adult (16 and older) application fees are \$60. Children are \$40. Some passport facilities require that these fees be paid with two checks as there are two components to the fees (Passport and Execution).

### ***Do You Need a Visa?***

For travel in some countries you will need a separate visa in addition to

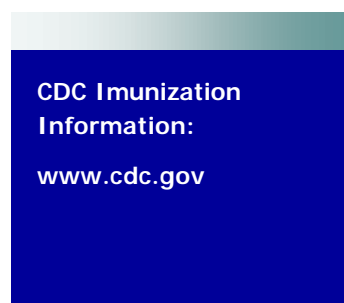
your US Passport. The country you are visiting issues the visa. You usually have to order a visa from the country's embassy. In many countries you will not need a visa for short visits, but you may need a photo ID or proof of US citizenship. You can find current information on the entry requirements for the country you are visiting at <http://travel.state.gov/foreignentryreqs.html> or talk to your travel agent.

### ***Just in Case***

The State Department recommends that you make two copies of your passport identification page. Leave one copy at home with friends or relatives.

### ***Immunizations***

Under the International Health Regulations adopted by the World Health Organization, a country may require International Certificates of Vaccination against yellow fever, especially if you are traveling from an area of the world that is infected with yellow fever. Check with health care providers or your records to ensure other immunizations (e.g. tetanus and polio) are up-to-date. Prophylactic medication for malaria and certain other preventive measures are advisable for travel to some countries. No immunizations are required to return to the United States. Detailed health information is included in Health Information for International Travel, available from the U.S. Government Printing Office (address on page 20) for \$20 or may be obtained from your local health department or physician or by contacting the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, telephone 1-877-FYI-TRIP (1-877-394-8747), toll-free autofax: 1-888-CDC-FAXX (1-888-232-3299), or Internet: [www.cdc.gov](http://www.cdc.gov).

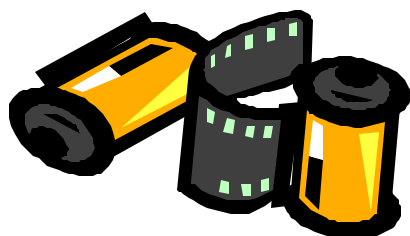
## Protect Your Film

On international flights automated baggage scanning technology now uses a combination of X-rays and computed tomography (CAT scan) to detect suspicious packages and explosives.

When the equipment sees anything suspicious (like metal canisters) it zaps it with a high powered X-ray scan.

This will damage any unprocessed film, whether or not it has been through a camera. The damage is not visible until the film is processed.

To be safe, carry your unprocessed films and loaded cameras in your carry-on luggage in a lead lined bag.



These lead lined bags are available at Noble's, they come in a number of sizes and are reusable.
